- Security - when departing please ensure all lights are turned off, air conditioner is off and all windows and doors are locked.
- Ensure gate is locked on each time you enter or exit the island (The bond will be forfeited if this is left open).
- Rubbish to wheelie bin (at shack) A community rubbish bin is on the right hand side after exiting through the gate if the rubbish exceeds the wheelie bins capacity.
- No camp fires
- THIS PROPERTY HAS NO JETTY. PLEASE DO NOT USE THE JETTIES NEXT DOOR.

Things to know about the house...

- Parking can be to the right of the shack and across the access road on the paved area in front of the small shed and to the left of the small shed.
- Only filtered river water is available in the house, please bring drinking water.
- The evaporative air conditioner is located in the lounge/kitchen area. Please remember to turn off on departure.
- There is a public boat ramp located under the bridge.
- This property has no jetty.

Please do not use the neighbouring jetties.

- The BBQ on the deck is for your use. The gas is turned off at the cylinder and there should be sufficient gas for your needs. Please ensure that the gas is turned off at the bottle on departure.
